


#### Why is it important to Integrate ABE with Technical Programs?

- Integrated adult basic education (reading, writing & math) with professional instructors is to provide basic education and workforce together.
- Students must first take all levels of basic education before the technical programs: Purpose to help provide post-secondary education and help the students become marketable and enter the healthcare workforce.
- One instructor teaches the students reading, writing, math & employability skills, while the other instructor teaches the technical courses and how to apply the skills as professionals.
- During the ABE course the students will improve their basic reading and writing and math skills using materials related to the health care industry.

# We are Ready to Meet the Challenge

HOUSTON HAS BEEN CHALLENGED WITH THE TASK OF FINDING WELL-TRAINED, PROFESSIONAL INDIVIDUALS TO FILL WHAT ARE KNOWN AS "MIDDLE-SKILLED OCCUPATIONS".

A REPORT RELEASED BY THE GREATER HOUSTON PARTNERSHIP HIGHLIGHTS THAT BETWEEN 2016 AND 2020 THE REGION WILL HAVE 84,257 JOB OPENINGS AVAILABLE FOR POSITIONS THAT REQUIRE MORE THAN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA BUT LESS THAN A FOUR-YEAR DEGREE.

### **Career Preparedness is the Goal**

- In order for clients ultimately to move forward on the pathway to receiving a certification and employment, they would need to successfully meet both academic benchmarks and professional expectations. Volunteers of America Texas began with a "gaps analysis" to understand how to address areas where clients fail to transition successfully up the ladder of professional growth due to lack of information, support or training.
- VOATX designed the Foundational Skills program to provide academic and professional skills training for clients in order to enhance their likelihood of long-term professional success along a healthcare pathway

### **Career Preparedness is the Goal**

- VOATX has a contextualized curriculum, reflecting healthcare content and led by skilled adult-educator and healthcare training provider.
- The core elements of the curriculum include: Math Reading • Computer literacy • Understanding healthcare careers (required training, work expectations, pay scale, professional growth opportunities) Professionalism skills (interviewing, resumes, communication, conflict, etc.)

#### **Success Story**

- Shamorrow, a young teen who dropped out of high school

- Lacking confidence to complete her education and get a career

- 10+ years after school, wanted a change

- Completed GED, and was looking to get out of fast food industry

- Enrolled in HPOG, started Medical Billing & Coding training

- Integrated curriculum helped overcome challenges

- Coaching support & personal motivation = successfully passing certification exam

- Now gainfully employed at a medical clinic @ \$17/hour
