Occupational Skills Training & Stackable Credentials

- Nurse's Aide → Medication Aide → Prerequisites → Licensed Practical Nurse → Registered Nurse
 - ▶ Prerequisites → Accepted into Registered Nursing Program (Starts in Fall) → Nurse's Aide/Medication Aide During Summer Semester → Begin Nursing Classes in Fall
- ▶ Ed2Go: Pharmacy Tech & Medical Terminology
- Community Colleges EMT, Respiratory Therapy, Medical Office Assistant, Health Records Coding, Medical Administrative Management, Phlebotomy, Pharmacy Technician, Clinical Medical Assistant

Reengagement: What Happens When They Disappear...

- ► Why?
 - Program wasn't what they expected
 - ▶ Already feel level of achievement from completing Foundational and/or OST; earned credentials and that was "enough."
 - ▶ Life circumstances change, not able to continue
 - Financial pressures need to earn income before program completion
- Reengagement?
 - Meet participants off-site to have conversations
 - ▶ Plan fun activities: picnics, movie night, class potluck, day at the park, etc.
 - Revisit visions boards, looking at and potentially reworking to reflect current goals and their previously established goals, change focus for occupational skills training, etc.
