

Organizational Assessment

Ladder of Youth Involvement



- Youth Initiated and Directed
 - Designed and run by youth and decisions made by youth
- 2. Youth Initiated, Shared Decisions with Adults
 - Designed and run by youth who share decisions with adults
- Youth and Adult Initiated and Directed
 - · Designed and run by youth and adults in full partnership
- 4. Adult Initiated, Shared Decisions with Youth
 - Minimum Youth Participation, designed and run by adults who share decisions with youth
- 5. Consulted and Informed
 - Designed and run by adults who consult with youth, Youth make recommendations that are considered by adults
- Assigned and Informed
 - Youth do not initiate, but understand and have some sense of ownership
- 7. Tokenism
 - Symbolic representation by few, may not have genuine voice, may be asked to speak for the group they represent
- 8. Decoration
 - Adults use youth to promote or support a cause without informing youth
- Manipulation
 - Youth are not involved in design or decisions; Youth involvement used by adults to communicate adults' messages

- What does authentic youth engagement look like?
- What do young people care about?
- Outreach, recruitment and retention
- Social marketing

Resource Allocation and Development

- Human resources
- ► Financial resources
- Keep track of what it takes to involve young people in leadership and advocacy roles.

Family Involvement

- Different backgrounds, different expectations in family involvement
- What opportunities and challenges do families face?
- ▶ Letting loose without letting go.

Peer Support Services

- ► Intentional peer support
- Lived experiences
- Motivate
- Engage
- Advocate

Hiring Young Adults with Lived Experiences

- Maybe their first professional job
- Maybe system's first experience hiring young people with lived experiences
- Young people's personal experiences with "systems" influence their networking approach.
- Supervision and mentoring
- Work hours
- How to maintain authentic youth voice when working for the "system".

Other Things to Consider

- Cognitive health affecting memory, judgment, intuition, thinking, reasoning, the ability to learn.
